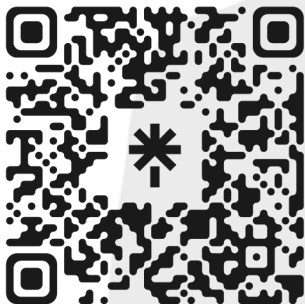




Rage LED RSV-1 Includes:

- Mesh Bag

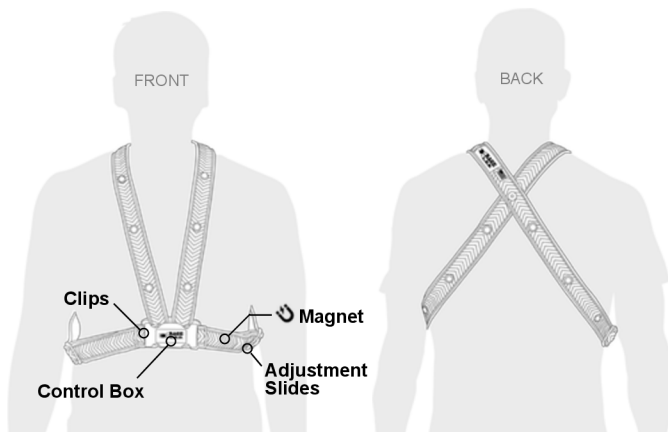
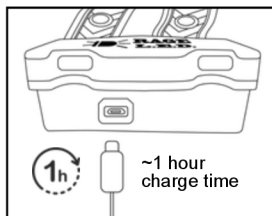

Charge:

Using included USB cable, locate micro USB port on bottom of control box. Plug in USB cable matching orientation. Plug in to USB 2.0+ (5v/1A) port.

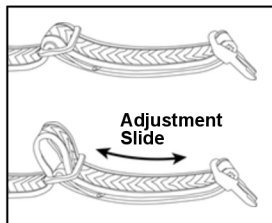
A red LED next to the USB port will light up to indicate battery charging. The red LED turns OFF when vest is fully charged.



Wear/Adjust:

Remove vest from bag, placing it on shoulders with center pivot resting behind the head allowing the control box to rest on the front abdomen.

TO RESIZE: Move adjustment slide toward or away from buckles to adjust vest size for optimal comfort.



Basic Operation:

Locate the clips now hanging at your back. Insert clips into the corresponding sides of the control box...

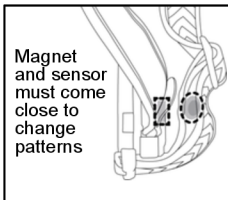
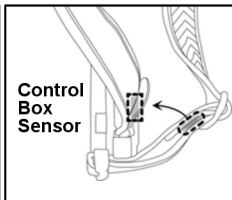
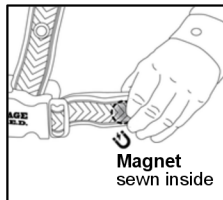
THIS IS WHERE THE MAGIC HAPPENS



LED Patterns:

The vest starts up to the last pattern used.

TO CYCLE LED PATTERNS: Locate RageLED logo on the back of the control box, and magnet near left side clip. Keeping the magnet flat to the sticker, quickly press the magnet to the logo and remove. Repeat method to cycle through patterns. Patterns repeat once end is reached.



Troubleshooting:

Vest not powering on:

- Are the vest clips plugged in to the box? The unit **powers** on when clips are fully plugged in to control box.
- Are the clips fully seated in to the control box?
- Is the battery charged?

Vest not charging:

- Check that red LED is lighting up when plugging in USB.
- Check that USB is plugged in and seated both on vest and power source.

Patterns not changing:

- Are the buckles clipped in and vest powered on?
 - Make sure magnet is in correct location on back of control box.
 - Check that the magnet is flat against control box when changing patterns.

- Make sure to fully remove/replace the magnet from the box when changing patterns.

This device contains a Lithium-polymer battery. This battery must be recycled or disposed of properly. Contact your local waste management office for information on battery recycling and disposal. Use a standard USB 2.0 port (or above) to recharge the battery using the USB charging port. Improper charging will ruin the battery and vest, voiding all warranties. Do not attempt to open the rechargeable battery or control box. There are no user serviceable parts inside. Contact support for further assistance. Keep the battery away from children. If swallowed, consult poison control immediately. Do not dispose of battery in a fire, as it may explode. The battery may also explode or catch fire if damaged or punctured.
